District 211 Foundation Mission

The mission of the Township High School District 211 Foundation is to obtain and provide resources to enhance and enrich learning opportunities for the students, staff, and school community of Township High School District 211.

Purpose of Grant Opportunities

Grants are intended to develop ideas, programs or practices that are not initially funded from within the regular school or district budget. Grants will be awarded for projects or programs that have the potential to impact student learning and development.

Grants will be given priority for new projects and programs. If funding is available, continuation of prior grants and/or replication of previously funded grants will be considered. Funding for an additional year will require an attached report listing positive results and detailed funding expenditures. This report must be attached to the grant application.

Criteria for Evaluating the Grant Proposals

1. Project's benefit for students and/or school district.
2. Project is innovative or creative.
3. Project ideas are realistic.
4. Project ideas are educationally sound, based on best knowledge, practice, or research.
5. Project goals and objectives are clearly stated and measurable.
6. Methods to be used are clearly described.
7. Application meets the deadline for submission.
8. Application is within the \$1,000 budget limitation.
9. Project meets building site modification requirement and/or curriculum committee approval, as needed.

Application Process

Reporting Requirements

Grant recipients must submit a final written report within 4 weeks after the completion of the project, to the Foundation's Vice-Chair of Projects. Awarded projects are to be completed within 1 year of funding.
